SEASONAL CAMPING FEES DUE NO LATER THAN JULY 2ND

Camping dues (\$120) for the second half of 2018 are due no later than close of business July 2nd. (Normally the deadline would be the 1st of July, however, this year that date is on a Sunday and the Club will be closed.) NO GRACE PERIOD. Remember, checks or money orders only preferred, made out to the NDA. - Thanks, Kurt Kleinhans, Camping Chairman

REMINDER: Campers keep your campsite mowed and the trash picked up around it. A general reminder to all members spending time at the Farm....be sure to clean up after yourself, lock up and turn out the lights in the A-frame and under the Shelter when you leave.

FARM GUESTS: Remember...you can take your guests 'fishing at the Farm'. As part of our goal to make the Farm self-sufficient the following guest policy is in place. Guest will be required to purchase an "Honorary Membership Card" from the Club for specific dates desired. Cost will be \$10 a day or you may purchase a two day card for \$15. The 2 day card must be used on consecutive days. Upon purchasing the card the guest will sign a waiver releasing the Club from any and all liabilities. The member bringing the guest must be with the guest when they get their card and must be with the guest on Club or Farm property at all times while the guest is there. Guest will be held to the same rules as the member and it is the member's responsibility to make sure the guest knows the rules and abides by them.

CLUB YOUTH, JUNIORS, & ADULTS COONSKIN CAP BRIGADE

COONSKIN is a three-day weekend (four-year progressive program) to teach hunting and trapping skills. The proper methods of taking and preparing game are demonstrated. Instruction and practice in the use of bow, blackpowder, rifle, shotgun, handgun shooting, knife and hawk throwing are also part of the program.

This is an excellent program to teach outdoor living, flint and steel fire making, open fire cooking, orienteering, and much more is offered. Make a coonskin cap, a bird house, decoys, hunt for pheasant, and make your own hunting knife during this four year program. Sign up today! Adult sponsors will participate with the youth. Adults not attending as a sponsor will be in a separate group.

Who: Anyone 10 years and over (And those who become Junior Leaders and Instructors)
