August 18th and 21st



Summer is flying by and before you know it, many of us will be thinking of getting in the woods to pursue the elusive white-tailed deer.



This year we are trying something new. We are allowing our members the opportunity to hunt at the farm with a bow or crossbow. This opportunity is open to members and their spouses as well as their children and grandchildren that are under the age of 21. First, each individual must qualify. **Qualification dates are Saturday August 18th from 9am till noon and again on Tuesday August 21st from 5-8pm.** There is a \$10 fee to qualify. Qualification will be at the Farm and consist of target shooting with the bow you intend to use for hunting. Those that qualify will then be entered into a lottery drawing to be held at the club on September 9th at 2pm. Those that are drawn in the lottery will have to pay a \$25 fee to hunt. Each lottery winner will get a 3 week period to hunt in 1 of our 3 tree stands that will be up. Official Archery Deer Hunting Regulations

1. Members, their spouses, their children and their grandchildren under the age of 21 are all eligible to hunt at the NDA farm. Those under 21 must have the card carrying member with them at all times while hunting.

2. All individuals must qualify with the weapon they will hunt with. If you use a compound bow and a crossbow, you must qualify with both weapons.

3. To qualify, the individual must hit a 10" diameter target 4 out of 5 times at a distance of 20 yards.

4. There will be a \$10 non-refundable fee to qualify. You may only attempt to qualify 1 time.

5. There will be 2 separate qualifying dates to be announced at a later date.

6. After qualifications there will be a lottery drawing to determine who will hunt what stand on what dates. If you are drawn as a hunter there will be a \$25 hunting fee that must be paid by a date set by the committee. Failure to pay by the specified date will result in forfeiture of

your draw and an alternate will be put into that slot.

7. Hunters may trade their draw dates with other lottery members but it must be approved by the committee and they must trade the entire period they were drawn

8. The committee with put up 3 stands for hunting. You are not allowed to put up your own stand. With 19 weekends during the archery season the time periods for the stands will be 3 weeks per stand with the exception of the last draw which will be a 4 week stand. So each stand will have 5-3 week sessions and 1- 4 week session. Thru the season that will put 6 different hunters in each stand, for a total of 18 hunters having the opportunity to hunt our farm.

9. At the lottery drawing we will announce what stand and what dates we are drawing for then draw a hunter.

10. Each hunter is allowed only 1 deer.

11. Hunt stands will be placed in a zoned area. If the hunter wishes to hunt from the ground he may do so but must stay within the established boundaries.

12. Only the committee will trim trees for improved shooting. If a hunter has an issue he/she can contact the committee and address it with us.

13. All vehicles must be parked either in the main lot or the range parking area.

14. All hunters must carry a permission form from the NDA at all times while hunting.

15. All hunters must sign a release of liability form.

16. All Ohio hunting laws will be strictly adhered to. Any individual caught violating any Ohio law or club rule while hunting the NDA property will have their membership revoked and we will assist law enforcement with prosecution if applicable.

** Please note that since this is our first attempt at doing something like this we know that some changes may be made to these rules to improve this opportunity for our hunters. We will always be open to suggestions to make this an enjoyable event for everyone. **

** The committee has the right to make any changes to the rules set up at any time throughout the season **

Marksmanship Shoots

CLUB YOUTH, JUNIORS, & ADULTS COONSKIN CAP BRIGADE

COONSKIN is a three-day weekend (four-year progressive program) to teach hunting and trapping skills. The proper methods of taking and preparing game are demonstrated. Instruction and practice in the use of bow, blackpowder, rifle, shotgun, handgun shooting, knife and hawk throwing are also part of the program.



This is an excellent program to teach outdoor living, flint and steel fire making, open fire cooking, orienteering, and much more is offered. Make a coonskin cap, a bird house, decoys, hunt for pheasant, and make your own hunting knife during this four year program. Sign up today! Adult sponsors will participate with the youth. Adults not attending as a sponsor will be in a separate group.


September 8th
